2. Advocate for and support state constitutional amendments and public policies that advance equality, justice, and civil rights.
3. Advocate against state constitutional amendments and public policies that damage equality, justice, and civil rights.
4. Engage and activate communities in political participation aligned with the values of Ha'aheo (pride), 'Ohana (family), Kaulike (justice), and Ui (activation).
